The Homocystinurias are a group of rare metabolic disorders whereby the amino acid (building blocks of protein), homocysteine, cannot be broken down in the body to be used as energy, especially in times of fasting or illness, and are treated through dietary changes and medications. When undiagnosed or left untreated, severe medical complications and/or death can occur.

The focus of this conference is for families to learn more about the medical management, nutrition and the mental, social, and emotional needs of those living with, and caring for a person with one of the homocystinurias. This is a great opportunity for families to meet each other and have the opportunity to speak with professionals on an informal level. We will hear from a variety of speakers: medical professionals, dieticians, social workers and genetic counselors.

Families living with homocystinuria have significant financial burdens with high medical bills, prescription costs, low protein foods and formula, and all that goes into caring for a loved one with a rare disease. 
